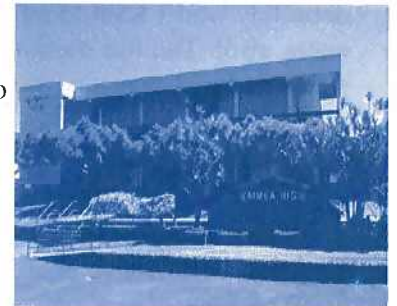
Campus Tour Scheduled
